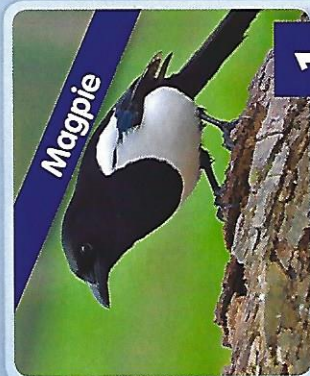

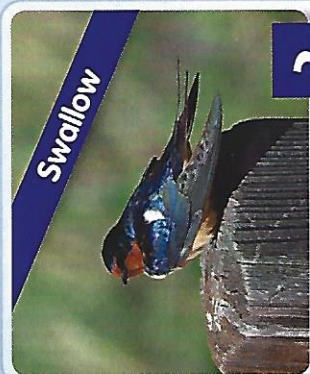


Magpie

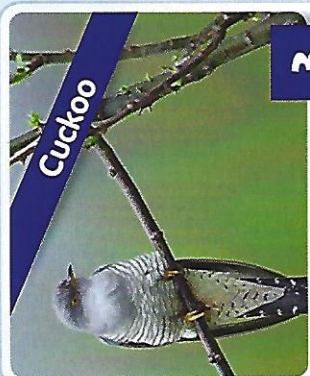

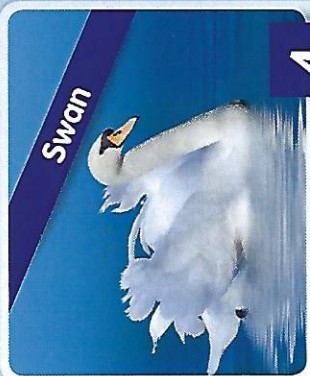

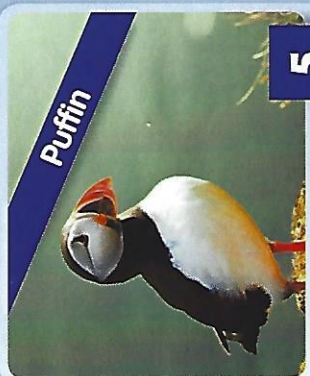

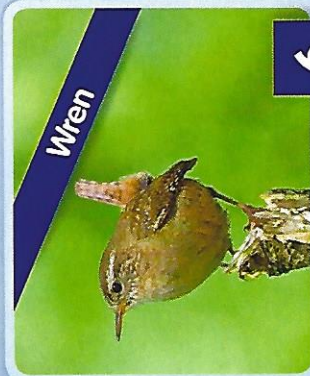

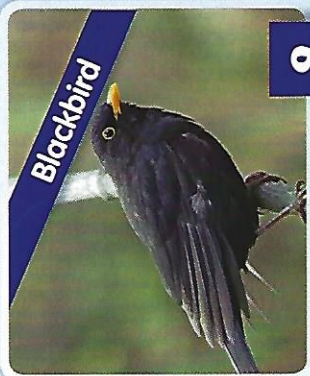

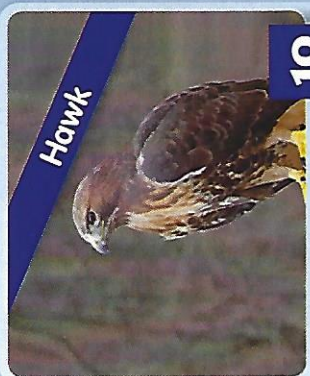
