**Forest School** is a unique outdoor learning experience that improves children's self esteem, confidence and abilities.

### Why become a Forest School Leader?

This course enables you to set up and run Forest School sessions in your setting, you will enable children and young people to regularly engage with the natural environment.

You will investigate how best to design and run a Forest School programme and look at how to approach and apply it safely and effectively.

This course is aimed at individuals who have a minimum Level 2 qualification in Youth Work, Child Care, Teaching OR relevant experience in working with children. The recommended age for a Forest School Practitioner is 21 years.
