Job Title: Local Fundraiser – Part-Time 15 hours a week/Seasonal

Salary: After successful completion of 2-week Trial Period (paid at £10 per hour) then freelance/self-employed/seasonal March-October – typically £702-£1170 per month commission.

Locations: Positions available across Lancashire, Manchester and North Merseyside.

Closing date: Applications accepted all year round. To start ASAP, but start date negotiable.

- Would you like to help the Lancashire Wildlife Trust achieve its aim of finding new members and additional funding in your neighbourhood and beyond, and to do so without ANY selling or persuading?
- Would you like to earn some extra income by doing something that you really believe in?
- Do you have around 15 hours a week to spare, primarily during weekday evenings?
- Following the tried and tested “Soft Approach” formula, the post involves walking around the more prosperous streets in your local area (and beyond), asking residents a simple yes/no question, and leaving information booklets about Lancashire Wildlife Trust with interested people.
- The work combines outdoor exercise with good potential earnings. No selling involved.
- **You will be working for FMR Solutions Ltd**, a specialist wildlife charity Membership Recruitment agency, on behalf of the Lancashire Wildlife Trust.
- Typically, the work is seasonal, March-October inclusive. However, some of our Local Fundraisers also work through the winter months.
- You will have good all-round communication skills, be able to work on your own without supervision, be socially confident in a wide variety of situations, and be good at organising your time and motivating yourself.
- You will have a genuine interest in wildlife conservation, but expert knowledge is not required.
- You must be able to enjoy walking 1–2 miles a day – usually in the “well off” suburbs of cities/towns and semi-rural areas.
- You must have your own transport (Bicycle OK in cities and larger towns).
- This post does not involve any active selling or persuasion, but some sales, marketing, promotion, face to face public engagement experience or similar, could be useful. Full training is provided. There is fully paid 2-week trial period.
- Mature applicants welcome.
