Quick and easy fundraising ideas



These ideas are perfect for offices, small teams or workspaces looking for quick fundraisers



Bake for wildlife

Host a bake sale, coffee morning or cake competition and ask colleagues to donate for a slice.

- ✓ Easy to organise
- ✓ Low cost
- ✓ Suitable for any workplace



Dress down day

Invite colleagues to wear casual clothes, wear green or dress for a wildlife theme in return for a donation.

- ✓ Quick to organise
- ✓ Encourages participation
- ✓ Works well in any size team



Nature photography competition

Ask colleagues to submit their favourite wildlife/landscape photo and vote for a winner with a small entry fee.

- ✓ Wildlife themed
- ✓ Accessible for everyone
- ✓ Great for hybrid teams



Quiz night

Host a lunchtime or after-work quiz and charge a small entry fee, extra points for a wildlife theme round

- ✓ Team building
- ✓ Hold in person or online
- ✓ Friendly competition

Team Challenges

Perfect for bringing colleagues together around a shared goal



Sponsored walk

Take on a walk together and ask friends, family and colleagues to sponsor your efforts.

Top tip



Choose a local nature reserve or green space and share photos throughout your challenge.



Kilometres for nature

Challenge your team to walk, run, cycle or row a combined distance over time.

Top tip



Create a team leaderboard and celebrate all of your team's milestones.



Office olympics

Create a series of fun workplace challenges and compete as teams with a small entry fee.

Top tip



Award prizes for participation as well as winning your fun workplace challenges.



Zero-waste challenge

Reduce waste for a week or month and ask supporters to sponsor your efforts.

Top tip



Set a team target and track your progress together and see the impact you have!



Bigger ways your workplace can support wildlife



From your first fundraiser to long-term partnerships, there are lots of ways your workplace can make a difference for nature.

Employee community funds

Ask whether your employer offers grants or funding that employees can nominate charities to receive.



Payroll giving

Some workplaces allow employees to donate regularly through their salary.

Charity of the Year

Nominate Lancashire Wildlife Trust and support local wildlife through workplace fundraising throughout the year.



Match funding

Many employers will match employee fundraising helping your support go even further.
